The Coordinators

- held an extensive exchange of views;
- approved the final structure of the hearing as detailed in a separate table, including estimates of the available speaking time; the hearing shall thus consist of three rounds ("Guaranteed water and sanitation for all in the EU"; "Global access to water and sanitation for all"; "No liberalisation of water services") and shall be held in the presence of Commission Vice-President Šefčovič as well as three high-level Commission officials, one for each of the three issues;
- agreed that, in addition to the 7 organisers¹, the ECI 'Right2Water' should be allowed to inviting additional members of the Citizens' Committee, i.e. up to 28 persons in total, the names of whom would be communicated in advance and who may be invited to answer questions on specific issues;
- noted that under the internal rules of the European Parliament, as adopted by the Bureau, only the travel expenses of up to 3 organisers may be reimbursed; decided that the chairman write to the President to seek the reimbursement of the travel expenses of up to 7 organisers and to suggest that the rules on reimbursement be adapted accordingly;
- decided unanimously, following an exchange of views, that no experts shall be invited so as to make more time available for political discussions between the organisers and Members of the European Parliament;
- invited the political groups to assure full attendance at the hearing and instructed the chair to write to the chairs of all the other committees so as to draw their attention to this hearing which could become a historic precedent.
