

# CONCEPT

The overarching concept for the Loch Leven Development Landscape Framework revolves around a central burn side park, which serves as the major corridor for both leisure and wildlife in the development.

A radial network establishes the footprints for urbanism, through which intersecting boulevards lead in the direction of the lock while offering expansive views from different perspectives.

These boulevards function as secondary green corridors, linking the and green and blue belts and serving as central wildlife and leisure spaces in the development.
