Researching into Malagueira

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Archives in the Age of Digital Humanities International Conference, Évora, 20181025

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Álvaro Siza Vieira (b.1933) is the most important living architect, profoundly recognized both nationally and internationally with prizes, nominations and exhibitions of built (1950s onwards) and unbuilt work in Portugal and in the world.

In 2014, Álvaro Siza decided to donate his extensive archive of built and unbuilt projects since 1958 to three institutions – the Serralves Foundation (FS) in Oporto, the Calouste Gulbenkian Foundation (FCG) in Lisbon and the Canadian Centre for Architecture (CCA) in Montreal.

The complete archive contains more than 60,000 drawings, 500 models, 282 sketchbooks and a large record of digital material illustrating built and unbuilt houses, museums, cultural centers, universities, city master plans and more from sites across the world. These documents need to be put into context using all other sorces of information (clients archives, local authorities and other architects)

Through this exceptional case of international institutional collaboration, the three institutions have committed to the establishment of a joint methodology of archival process and description that will allow collective access to Siza's significant body of work.

Álvaro Siza expressed his "desire that so many years of work can become useful in many ways, as a contribution to research and debate on architecture, particularly in Portugal and with a perspective opposed to isolation". As a result he communicated his decision to "donate to two Portuguese institutions that already have the experience, quality and capacity to develop or enlarge their respective archives with the goal of increasing access, dissemination and active participation in a debate that is no longer simply national nor centered on an individual," and to "donate to the CCA in Montreal, an institution of unequalled experience and prestige and with a sustained series of activities — exhibitions, publications, research, relations with other related institutions and large visibility".

As the CCA is recognized for its experience in the preservation and presentation of international archives, it will care for a large part of my archive and make it accessible alongside the work of other modern and contemporary architects."

Documentation as part of a living project

- In the process of designing buildings architects generate a large number of documents:
 - Design related
 - Construction related
 - Contextual documents

An archive of drawings is not dead paper

- Drawings are specific documents
- If they were identified with art theywould be in a museum is a Museum an Archive?
- Since they are not the Built Object are they architecture?
- Is a Sketchbook an architectural research?

Digital as a type of long distance access for others / exhibitions



The research aims:

- (O1) to collect and consolidate a documentary (such as drawings, plans, texts, documents, photographs) and theoretical corpus of knowledge as structured database of relevant information and identify and recognize the fundamental values authenticity, integrity, singularity and outstanding universal value of Malagueira;
- (O2) to develop, create, register and sustain a new brand MALAGUEIRA.PT that integrates cultural, architectural, historical, social and scientific values.
- (O3) to inform and communicate the existent and the non-built projects of Malagueira through new ICTs with mobile applications of augmented reality, providing unique interactive experiences (simple and intuitive) capable of producing new meanings, and, support the increase of local economic activities (such as the tourism), thus producing new contents that attract new tourists and contribute for the social recognition of Malagueira.
- (O4) to change from the stigma and negative interpretations of Malagueira towards the recognition of the value of modern heritage and of Malagueira by a new cultural and heritage paradigm resulting from the accumulation of experiences of its community;
- (O5) to elaborate a Heritage Charter with the management tools necessary for Unesco's nomination that will allow building and empowering the community and partners on the work of ASV.
- (O6) to build, inspire and maintain a community of national ASV partners.
